EX3 POLICY

Parent/Guardian, by signing below, you understand and agree to the following drop-in policy, clothing policy, damage agreement, medical waiver, media release and behavior policy.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK, CONSENT FOR TREATMENT: Participation in programs sponsored by the Boys & Girls Clubs of King County and use of the Clubs' facilities involve potentially hazardous activities such as running, jumping, strenuous exercise and use of equipment that could lead to serious injury and death. We, the undersigned, acknowledge and assume all these risks. In exchange for participation in the programs and using the Clubs' facilities, we release and agree to hold harmless the Clubs, their agents, employees, officers and directors from all claims for injury, death, property damage and expense, including attorney's fees, arising from participation in the Clubs' programs and use of the Clubs' facilities, including transportation for activities both on and off site. The undersigned also consents to his/her child(ren) being given emergency treatment by staff, physician, EMT, or hospital in case of accident or illness.

DROP-IN POLICY

The EX3 Ron Sandwith Teen Center staff does not grant permission to teens to leave the Club, nor do they insist that teens stay. **The decision as to when a teen arrives and leaves the Club, and with whom they leave with is a matter handled between parent and child.** Teens not mature enough to capably handle this responsibility should have the close supervision of other, more appropriate programs.

DRESS CODE

In order to provide a positive environment for all members of EX3, there will be no inappropriate dress. This includes, but is not limited to, clothing that advertises the use of drugs or alcohol, sexually suggestive or revealing clothing, ripped or torn clothing, "do-rags," Bandanas, hats or any clothing that suggests "Gang" affiliation.

BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT POLICY

Philosophy

EX3 recognizes that its members are young adults and strives to treat them as such. In order for this to occur, EX3 asks that its members take responsibility for their actions and behave in a manner that makes this environment possible. EX3 members understand that they are responsible for their behavior and will act in a manner that is respectful to themselves and their environment.

EX3 asks that all members refrain from behavior that can be considered:

- *Dangerous* – anything that could cause physical harm to oneself or someone else.
- *Disrespectful* – anything that could hurt someone else's feelings, but also includes talking back to staff, and mismanaging Club equipment.
- *Destructive* – anything that could break something that belongs to oneself, another member, and the Club.
- *Disruptive* – anything that prevents the group from completing its activity.
- *Dishonest* – anything that involves lying, cheating, or stealing.

EX3 recognizes that people of all ages make mistakes, and mistakes are a part of learning and personal growth. EX3 staff will strive to allow its members to learn from their mistakes by providing youth with opportunities to overcome behaviors that are barriers to personal growth.

Behavior Management Procedures

The following steps will be taken by EX3 in the event of behavior problems:

- Staff will communicate with the individuals involved in an attempt to resolve the situation.
- Staff will immediately respond to further behavior from those involved in negative behavior, and consequences for the continued behavior will be implemented. (These may be loss of privileges, service to the Club or removal from the premises)

- In the event of continued behavior management issues, the parties involved may be asked to remove themselves from EX3 and Truman High School Property. In the event the member refuses, Federal Way Police may be contacted and a no-trespass order may be issued.
- In order to provide a positive and safe environment a Suspension/Loss of membership may be required for continued negative behavior. (**Refunds will not be given for suspensions or loss of membership**).
- EX3 reserves the right to implement the steps in the Behavior Management Policy in any order it deems fit. The above listed Intervention Steps are not inclusive and do not limit EX3 staff from applying other steps of behavior management not listed above

All parties involved should be aware that EX3 has a **zero tolerance policy** towards violence, weapons, threats, intimidation and harassment. **Immediate Suspension** and possible loss of membership will occur should a member be involved in any of the above listed behaviors. Members and parents/guardians of members not yet of legal age understand that they will be required to pay all fees/damages incurred from any behavior that violates EX3 policy.
